***** (BREEDER/SELLER) wants to ensure our babies are indeed going to forever homes. Purchaser (BUYER) AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING:



This Piglet is being sold as a PET. ***** does NOT sell any piglet for breeding purposes. **Permanent ownership of this piglet/pig is contingent upon the compliance with this agreement contract.** This piglet is sold as a PET. Buyer agrees to spay/neuter this piglet between the age of 4 to 6 months old and guarantees this piglet/pig will NOT be used for stud or breeding.



This piglet is to be spayed/neutered on or before: _____ Spay/neuter documentation must be sent to the SELLER prior to the pig turning 7 months old. If spay/neuter documentation from the veterinarian is not provided to ***** by the date above, BUYER is legally obligated to pay an additional cost of a breeder pig (a minimum of \$3700) to the SELLER immediately and the SELLER reserves the right to confiscate the pig (and any piglets that may be the result of breeding, accidental or otherwise) if the proof of spay/neuter is not provided to the SELLER by the piglet turning 7 months of age, with no financial return! *There have been reports of mini pig fatalities due to the use of the anesthesia Ketamine and also Halothane. Isoflurine has been proven to be a much safer anesthesia. Please discuss this with your veterinarian. **Spaying and neutering after the age of 8 months old has been found to be life threatening in mini pigs.



This pig/piglet will be kept indoors and will never be allowed to roam freely outside without a proper fenced in area and/or while in a harness with a leash.



If this piglet is found to be neglected or mistreated at any time, BUYER will surrender said piglet/pig to the SELLER unconditionally.

If at any time, the BUYER can no longer retain possession of this pig, the SELLER is to be notified and given the option of resuming full ownership of the pig. Should any circumstances arise that affect the quality of the life of the pig, the BREEDER/SELLER is to be informed so that they may participate in determining the future of the pig. The BREEDER reserves the right to approve/prohibit any transfer of this animal to a third party. Under no circumstances will this pig be sold, leased, traded, or given away to an unstable home, to any pet shop, research laboratory, animal shelter, pig sanctuary, or any similar facility. In the event that the BUYER cannot keep their ***** Pig, BUYER agrees to allow the SELLER to find a perfect home for adoption and placement of the piglet at free of charge.



The BUYER agrees to provide a life-long commitment, comfortable environment, prompt medical attention, proper grooming, and responsible care for this mini pig. This includes, but is not limited to, providing proper nutrition, which consists of a good quality professional feed, given at regular intervals, and fresh water available at all times. The BUYER promises to provide a safe environment for the pig, free of predators, and a loving and affectionate long-term home. BUYER promises to never allow the pig to roam freely without proper fencing or supervision. The SELLER strongly recommends that the piglet be microchipped (if not done by the BREEDER prior to piglet being sold) in order to facilitate his return if lost or stolen.



The BUYER agrees to contact the SELLER immediately if ANY concerns or questions arise about the pig, such as housing, diet, or health. The BUYER agrees to keep the SELLER informed of any treatment as it occurs. This provides the BREEDER/SELLER with an opportunity to follow up on piglets and gives us important feedback and information on the health of our pigs for future generations.



I, the BUYER, agree to provide a stable long-term home for my pig. I understand they live over a decade and I plan to raise my ***** Pig, its entire life. I agree to give my pig a lot of time, affection, and attention, and provide them with exercise, dirt for iron, grazing time in the grass, and they will be treated as a family member. I agree to be cautious of introducing our piglet to other pets, especially as babies, to ensure their safety. I agree to NEVER lock my pig up on a regular basis, they are highly intelligent and this damages their personality.



BUYER takes full responsibility for the zoning requirements depending on the city that the pig will reside in. SELLER does not check zoning or homeowner associations; this is the sole responsibility of the BUYER and upon moving to future locations as well. No refunds will be given if your city does not allow pet pigs and you take the risk of ownership.



SELLER takes no responsibility for pig's personality. Each *****



Piglet is handled daily to be socialized. If pigs are not given proper care and attention, they can become withdrawn or even aggressive. It is up to the BUYER to provide training, discipline, and exposure to animals and children at a young age, any animal, as

well as a pig, has the potential to be aggressive if they are not cared for properly.



We do not guarantee the size of any pig. We can only make an educated guess based on the size and age of both parents. Some piglets will grow to be smaller and some larger than their parents. So I freely tell you this up front in good standing.



The preceding paragraphs contain conditions established by the BREEDER/SELLER to ensure the well being of the piglet. The BUYER's agreement will continue for the duration of the pig's life and the SELLER will have the right to enforce the agreement.



No cash refund will be given under any circumstances.



Any legal action, which may arise under the terms of this contract, will be brought to the county and state of the BREEDER/SELLER. The BUYER shall be liable for all expenses in the amount of purchase of piglet, return shipping expenses, associated veterinary expenses, costs resulting from litigating this contract, and any damages caused to the reputation of *****

This document is a legally binding contract. In signing this document, the BUYER acknowledges that he/she read and fully understands and agrees to ALL of the terms and conditions stated above.

Health Guarantee

The BREEDER guarantees this piglet to be of sound health upon delivery to the BUYER. The BUYER has 72 hours to take piglet to a Licensed Veterinarian to be fully examined. If this piglet is found to be medically deficient with an untreatable or life threatening genetic disorder, the veterinarian must report it to the BREEDER immediately. All veterinary fees are the responsibility of the BUYER.

The BUYER must take the piglet to a LICENSED VETERINARIAN of their choice within 72 hours of delivery for a physical examination. In the very unlikely event that a piglet is determined to be in ill health, a new piglet will be issued, upon a signed written diagnosis from the said licensed veterinarian. The piglet can then be returned and will be replaced with another piglet of equal value of the purchase price or the purchase price may be refunded at the option of the BREEDER. If no replacement is available at that time, the seller will have 12 months to furnish a replacement. This piglet cannot be returned and no compensation will be made after the guarantee period of 72 hours has expired.

It is the responsibility of the BUYER to provide immediate veterinary care for this piglet if it shows any signs of illness or distress and failure to do so will render any guarantee null and void. Under no circumstance is this piglet to be destroyed prior to notification to the BREEDER if this piglet dies within the guarantee period despite medical treatment; compensation will ONLY be made if a LICENSED VETERINARIAN certifies the cause of death. In the event a piglet passes away within the 72-hour time frame, a licensed veterinarian must perform a necropsy after the BREEDER has been notified. The results must conclude that the piglet's death as due to a hereditary/congenital defect. The pig will be replaced only if a licensed vet performs the appropriate necropsy and a veterinarian certificate is provided as a proof of cause of death along with a copy of ALL medical records for the piglet. A replacement will then be made of a piglet of comparable quality and value as available, at the discretion of the BREEDER. The BREEDER assumes absolutely no responsibility for fees associated with

caring for the pig or accrued veterinary and / or necropsy expenses. No other guarantees are given.

This contract is legally binding to all parties involved. This contract applies only to the BUYER and the BREEDER/SELLER, as listed below and is non-transferable to any other parties. BUYER's signature indicated full understanding and agreement to the above conditions of this contract. In the event of a legal dispute, legal jurisdiction of the contract shall be in the county and state of the BREEDER/SELLER.
